
APRIL VACATION CARE


The CASAC Team are very excited for our fun filled April Vacation Care program (15th - 26th April 2024).

When a child demonstrates positive behaviours they are given a 'superstar' sticker to add to our Superstar Thermometer.


The Superstar Thermometer includes multiple smaller rewards to achieve along the way to encourage resilience and consistency.





You can see the children's progress on the Superstar Thermometer when you next collect your child/ren!










